§ 2 The following provides you with information regarding the data sources, scope, purpose as well as the legal basis of data processing

2.1. Data Sources

If such information is available in publicly available sources, or provided by your company upon request for the appropriate contact person, that information will be used to address you. Otherwise, you voluntarily provide us with your data.

2.2 Scope of Data Processing

Based on the following data categories:

Data import/transfer

- Your data will be recorded in our CRM system and connected systems thereto
- Your data may be passed on internally within E.ON

2.3 Purpose and legal basis for data processing

The collection and further processing of your data serves to address you by e-mail, telephone or post, for the purpose of advertising, for quoting, for general communication with you and to initiate a contract

2.4 Legal Basis of Data Processing

Data processing based on our legitimate interests (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR), to

- a) inform you about products and services - Our goal is to establish, maintain and evaluate customer relationships with you, and
- b) provide you with relevant and optimized products and services.

§ 3. Data Access

Your personal data is stored in our CRM system. Only employees of the company have access to your data for, among other things, marketing and project work. A transfer of personal data takes place only for specific purposes and according to the data protection regulations.

§ 4. Retention Period

4.1 Data Retention Period

We retain your personal data for a maximum of 2 years, unless there are legal or statutory requirements that it be retained for a longer or shorter period or you have granted consent to a longer retention period.

§ 5. Your Rights

You have the following rights:

- **Right to access:** You are entitled to request - at any time within the scope of statutory provisions and at no cost to you - information on your data we process, the purpose of such processing, how long the data is retained or the criteria used in determining how long it is retained as well as the recipients of the data.
- **Right to rectification, erasure and restriction of processing:** If your personal data we process is incorrect, incomplete or the processing of the data is not permitted, you may request that we rectify, complete or restrict the processing of your data, or erase the data within the scope allowed by law. To assert your rights, please contact your business representative, or data protection officer at any time.
- **Right to data portability:** If you provided us with data voluntarily or as part of an existing contractual relationship with us, we will make this data available to you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format at your request, provided this data does not contain confidential business information and does not involve a work product. Where technically feasible, we will transmit this data to a third party designated by you.

- **Right to lodge a complaint:** You are welcome to direct any questions, suggestions or criticisms to our Data Protection Officer. In addition, you can also direct a complaint at any time to a supervisory authority. When doing so, you may choose to approach the supervisory authority with jurisdiction over the place of your residence or the supervisory authority with jurisdiction over our establishment.
